Good ethics and etiquette are fundamental to bridge.

The IBA insists that players are treated with respect and dignity and is committed to providing a friendly atmosphere in its club rooms

- $m{\mathcal{R}}$ espect other people's rights to have different opinions or ways of thinking
- lacktriangle Conduct their game in a proper, mature and inoffensive manner
- Assist new members and guests and try to show patience and understanding
- At all times abide by this Code of Conduct as well as the rules of the IBA, NSWBA and the Australian Bridge Federation

In addition members should be aware of their obligations under Laws 73 and 74 of the Laws of Duplicate Bridge
