Techniques For No Trumps

A cardplay workshop for the developing player.

Few things instil more anxiety in a beginning bridge player than having to play a hand in No Trumps!

This workshop will focus specifically on how to think about playing no trumps, including several techniques that will maximise your chance of making these contracts and minimise the damage when you go down.

Although all are welcome, there is a basic level of experience that will be assumed (we won't be learning to take finesses and play our long suits!) Techniques covered will include such topics as avoidance plays, safety plays and the important skill of combining one's chances to give the greatest chance for making our contract.

The course will include handouts discussing each hand, allowing participants to take the lesson away to study at their own pace.
